Members, having received a hired score could you please:

1. Lightly put your name inside with soft pencil (next to pencil-written number of your score inside front cover - this is to avoid accidental swapping of scores during the term).
2. Spend a little time before next rehearsal rubbing out existing marks. Sorry if they're in a bad state - do the best you can.
3. Always use a soft pencil (2B or softer) and bring a rubber to rehearsals.
4. **DO NOT** fold the page corners.
5. **RUB OUT** any unnecessary pencil markings **BEFORE** the concert.
6. If you know you won't be singing in the concert, be sure to return your scores **BEFORE** the concert.
7. If for any reason you can't sing but had intended to, please return scores to the librarian as soon as possible but **NO LATER** than the Friday following the concert.
8. If your scores are overdue (and we hope they never will be!) there is a **£10 fine PLUS** the cost of a new book.
